

Entry Requirements To be eligible for Australian **Nursing Practice – Outcome** based assessment, an applicant is required to: Have completed a Bachelor of Nursing degree or an equivalent qualification Be a registered nurse with the Nurses' Board/Council from the country of origin or place of residence

Registered Nurses having a three-year Diploma of Nursing qualification and at least three years of experience as a registered nurse are eligible to enrol in this course
